### More information and abbreviation KEY

**STAR = S.T.A.R. Puppy**, Level 1 Manners: Open to puppies between 12 weeks and 5 months at the start of class. You will either take this class OR LYM, depending on your pup's age

**LYM = Learn Your Manners**: Open to adolescent and adult dogs over 5 months old at the start of class. Less direct play, more focus on impulse control. Dogs under one year can still earn their S.T.A.R. puppy title if they take this class

**STAR/LYM** = A combined age class. All dogs must be at least 15 weeks old at the start of class. Younger pups are encouraged to take the Saturday STAR Puppy class, but allowances can be made based on schedule. However, like the LYM class, there will be less direct free play and more focus on impulse control in this class

**MYM = Mind Your Manners, Level 2 Manners**: Must be a graduate of Learn Your Manners or STAR Puppy and must be at least 5 months old. There is more distraction, distance, and duration of time added to behaviors you and your dog have already learned. There is also the introduction of new, more advanced skills

**Make-Ups**: Only 1 class is allowed to be taken as a make-up free of cost, and it is only free of cost if instructor is given a 48-hour notice. Make-ups with less than the 48-hour notice cost are charged at \$20/class. These are designated make-up times and you will work on the topic and behaviors that you missed
